WHEREAS, the Designee of the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools of the Inglewood Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of **Education** Code Section 60119 held a public hearing at five thirty p.m. on Wednesday, October 9, 2019, which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours and;

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home to complete required homework assignments, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the Designee of the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials, or both, are available to use in class and to take home to complete required homework assignments, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English Learners that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

- Mathematics
- Science
- History-Social Science
- English/Language Arts, including the English Language Development component of adopted program

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WHEREAS, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instruction materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes, and:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that for the 2019-2020 academic year, the Inglewood Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
